

VMCC (TAVERNERS) - SPORTING TRIAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Jurisdiction: Held under AMCA regulations and any issued final instruction.

2. Eligibility: Any members of the VMCC and/or AMCA with eligible machines.

4. Entries: The Trial Entry will be limited to 45 Riders. **Entries to be received, by the Secretary, no later than the Monday prior to the event. No entries will be allowed on the day.**

5. Entry Fee: See table below. Cheques made payable to "The Taverners".

6. Location: The trial will be held, on private ground, at: **Crossway Farm, Stainby**

7. Date/Time: The trial will be held on: **12th February 2012.**

Signing-on commencing at 10.00am.

First section opens at 10.30am.

D	Youth class aged 14-16 machines up to 250cc made before 31.12.56.	£6
E	Youth class aged 11-13 machines up to 200cc made before 31.12.56	£6
G	Guest. Pre 1957 machines excluded from classes above (specials)	£17

9. Championship Points: Points will be awarded at each trial. 7 points for first place, 6 for second, 5 for third, 4 for fourth, 3 for fifth, 2 for sixth and 1 point for all finishers. At the end of the season the rider's best **seven** out of **eight** rounds of the series count towards the championship.

The Class winner will be awarded a trophy and a replica with second and third places in the championship receiving an award. Trophies will be presented at the Taverners Section Annual Dinner in November. If scores are tied at the end of the season the number of wins decides the Class winner.

10. Marking:

Not attempting a section:	Loss of 10 marks
Stopping in a section:	Loss of 5 marks
Footing more than twice in a section:	Loss of 3 marks
Footing only twice in a section:	Loss of 2 marks
Footing only once in a section:	Loss of 1 mark
No footing:	Loss of 0 marks

Ties will be decided, where possible, by the furthest clean.

11. Insurance: All riders will be covered against personal accident risks (Third Party, private land only) while taking part in this event. Minors are not covered.

12. Numbers: Vests indicating rider's number will be issued at signing on.

13. Helmets: Helmets to be worn by all competitors while riding *before, during and after the event*
